





Stenson, who also works with **Keltle Knight**, reveals. To create a softness that complemented the structure of her Alexis Monsanto gown with a gold embroidered bodice and blush skirt, he used lots of texturizer. "I applied it before blow drying, then again once the hair was dry before curling," he says. "I alternated a rope curl pattern throughout the entire head, then created a deep part for a soft side-sweep finish. Once the curls were placed, I broke them up for softness."

And for Kocian, 19, texture was the name of the game. "It's a departure from her usual stick-straight hair," Papanikolas said. To accompany the Olympian's navy blue Rita Vinieris column dress, the pro dried her hair and created all-around curls using a half-inch iron. Once all the hair was curled, he applied Matrix. StyleLink Mineral Play Back Dry Shampoo (\$18, matrix.com) as a finishing touch.


"It's all about texture," Stenson says. "We're used to seeing the gymnasts in top knots and really tight hairdos, so we wanted to keep it loose and fun and really show off the structure in the gowns."

Biles, Raisman and Kocian all wore their hair styled down with a range of waves and curls. Matrix products were used, and Stenson cited StyleLink Texture Builder medium-hold texturizing spray as the key product for styling Biles' hair, with some help from StyleLink Height Riser volumizing powder.

"With Aly, I don't think people really realize what incredible hair she has," Papanikolas says. "So what I wanted to do was really accent it and really show off the volume. Plus I've been doing her color as well, and you can really see it when we put the waves in."

Papanikolas has previously colored and styled Raisman's hair, and he also styled Kocian for the big event. Stenson worked with Biles and Dwyer before the red carpet.

"The looks are really soft; we don't want anything crunchy, and we don't want anything to be really tight," Stenson says. "It's all soft and flowy and beautiful and wearable."

SIMONE BILES - GOLDEN GLOBES

Nick Stenson inspiration: "We wanted to create softness to compliment the structure of the dress. Plus, she is known for having her hair up so we wanted to switch it up for this big day."

- 1. Start with a light weight texturizer foam to lock in hold then rough dry hair.
- Once dry, apply a texturizer spray. With a curling iron, alternate rope curl patterns throughout the entire head.
- 3. Create a deep part and use a comb to lightly brush and place the curls. This helps create a soft, side swept finish.
- 4. Lock in the look with a lightweight hairspray.

ALY RAISMAN - GOLDEN GLOBES

George Papanikolas inspiration: "Aly spends so much time in the gym and training with her hair pulled back. We wanted to really pull out all the stops for the Golden Globes and went for glam Hollywood waves. She already has amazing hair and I really wanted to maximize its volume and body."

- 1. On damp hair, apply a volumizing mousse and root powder. Blow dry with a round brush for a smooth but full finish.
- Once completely dry, take a 1-inch curling iron and create Marcel waves throughout. These waves are always a classic look on the red carpet!
- 3. Once the head is fully curled, finger brush hair lightly then apply a flexible hairspray to ensure hold with movement.
